KARTING AUSTRALIA


The power and authority to organise, control and regulate Karting within Australia has been formally delegated to Australian Karting Association Ltd (Karting Australia) by the General Assembly of the Federation Internationale de 'I Automobile (FIA) through Motorsport Australia.

Karting Australia is a member based, not-for-profit organisation. It has operated as a Company Limited by Guarantee with an independent Board and professional management since 1 September 2013. Karting is conducted in a Federated Structure, which means that our Member States and Clubs across the country have specific responsibilities for organising and conducting our sport.

The Member State Associations are legally distinct entities. They and their direct members, the Affiliated Karting Clubs, are required to follow all relevant laws and adhere to Karting Australia's Rules, By-Laws, Policies, and Procedures.

Outside of the Olympic Sports, motorsport has generated more international success for Australia than most other 'global' sports in this country. Motorsport has played an important role in Australia's cultural, sporting and economic history for the past 100 years. There are no truer words about Karting than "RACING STARTS HERE". We are the place where almost all modern day motorsport heroes first raced.

Motorsport delivers long-term social, sporting, community, and economic benefits. Karting is where the dream of international competition and conquering the best that the world has to offer begins, it is also where we provide "*RACING FOR ALL AGES*".

In accordance with this Strategic Plan and through our day to day business activities, Karting Australia will work to lead, guide, govern, and support the Australian Karting Community.

Karting is conducted in a **Federated Structure**, which means that our Member States and Clubs (both of which are legally distinct entities) have specific responsibilities for organising and conducting our sport in their own immediate areas. Those responsibilities differ to Karting Australia's role of managing, leading and guiding our sport nationally.

Member State Associations and Affiliated Karting Clubs, are required to adhere to Karting Australia's Constitution, Rules, By-Laws, Policies, and Procedures. The success of Towards 2030, and the strength of our Federation, requires our Member States and our Affiliated Clubs to see Towards 2030 as their own Strategy and to align their State and Club strategies with this plan.

Karting Australia's Purpose is to "LEAD, GOVERN, INSPIRE, PROMOTE AND GROW THE SPORT AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY OF KARTING IN AUSTRALIA". We will do that by collaborating with and leading the Karting Community. We want, and plan for karting to be more easily discovered, simpler to become part of and to stay active in as: drivers, team members, mechanics, administrators, and officials.

Planning for the next decade gives us the opportunity to address current Karting issues, and create a vision for the future of Karting, giving us an holistic approach to making Karting the best sport it can be.

Towards 2030 is now a 'living' document that will guide the long term work of Karting Australia and our Karting Community.

Our highest immediate priorities that are addressed in Towards 2030 are:

- · The shortage of race officials and volunteers required to run race meetings, Clubs and State Associations; and
- · Attracting, inducting, and retaining new and existing members at your clubs.

As with all good businesses, we can and must continue to be multi-faceted in our thought processes and actions and be active in all areas of our sport and business.
