ENTRY PROCEDURE

Each Entry for this Meeting will be made using the KOMP as follows:

- Log on to your driver information via the Karting Australia Licencing and Events Portal or App
- Select the Event from the Event Calendar
- Enter the required details to complete your Event entry

Payment of the Entry Fee can only be made via KOMP.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Eligibility is limited to drivers who are holders of a current A, B or C Grade KA licence.
- Drivers holding a licence issued by a foreign ASN must comply with Competition Rules, Chapter 4, Rule 22.
- D grade or provisional licence holders are not eligible to enter.
- Refusal or acceptance of entries is in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 17.
- The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel any event as in accordance with the Rules.
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

MINIMUM ENTRIES (Competition Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 I)

If less than 10 genuine entries are received to constitute a Class by the listed close of entries, then the Class may NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any Class shall be notified as soon as possible and entry fee will be returned.

NOTICE BOARD ENTRY CONFIRMATION AT THE START OF THE RACE MEETING

In lieu of an administrative checking session, an Official Entry List including transponder numbers will be posted on the Official Notice Board the afternoon of 27/06/2024.

It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all information on the Official Entry List is correct. Any inaccuracies or discrepancies are required to be notified to the Chief Timekeeper no less than 60 minutes prior to the start of Practice for their respective Class.

*Proof of purchase receipts for the Fuel must be retained and produced to the Chief Scrutineer, State Technical Inspector or Fuel Tester as and when required.

Control Fuel MUST be used from Friday 28/06/2024 until the conclusion of the Meeting on Sunday 30/06/2024.

*Random samples of Competitor's Fuel may be taken during the Meeting and tested for conformity to samples of the Control Fuel taken from the supplier on these dates. Competitors are reminded that Fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to being used for Fuel purchased for this Meeting. No dumping of Fuel will be allowed on site.

PRIZES:

Trophies will be awarded in accordance with the provisions of Competitions Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 u).

1st, 2nd and 3rd place trophies for all classes. Blue Plate for all class winners.

As per Competition Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 30, all drivers who qualify for an award are required to be present for the Presentation in their driving suit.

On the Friday evening, Ipswich Kart Club will have a Random Prize Draw Ceremony with prizes to be drawn and distributed. All entries go into the Random Prize Draw, but drivers must be in attendance at the Ceremony to claim the prizes as they are drawn.



GENERAL REGULATIONS

KART RETRIEVAL:

Ipswich Kart Club will have a MRV (Motorised Recovery Vehicle) in place during Qualifying and Racing. Karts can only be retrieved using a trolley via the Out Grid with the permission of the Grid Marshall.

Pit Crew must only enter the Track when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing an **ORANGE HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST** in accordance with the Rules.

It is the responsibility of Pit Crew to have their own Orange High Visibility Safety Vest. It is an offence to wear a Karting Australia Officials Vest, Refer General Rules, Chapter 8, Rule 5 m) (i) unless you are an official of the event. Karts can be retrieved via access through the In/Out Grid only.

INSURANCE:

Has been effected for this Meeting in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 3 of the 2024 KA Manual.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2024 KA Manual.

FRONT FAIRING (Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 g) (iii):

The Front Fairing Fitment Rules Will be used at this Meeting.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

Each engine and Chassis must be sealed and tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.

TIMING TRANSPONDER FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

MYLAPS compatible transponders must be mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 i)

Note: All Karts MUST have fitted and correctly charged and operating transponders for all sessions commencing 28/06/2024

VEHICLE / TRAILER ACCESS:

Trailer access will be available from Thursday June 27th. All vehicles not incorporated into a pit space must be removed from the pit area.

SECURITY:

Security will not be provided.

No unauthorised access will be provided outside Gate Opening Times.

PIT ALLOCATION:

Pit allocation will be in use for this Meeting.

Final allocation of Pit Space will be at the discretion of the Organiser.

CANTEEN:

Food Trucks will be onsite from Thursday Evening and operating from 10am Friday until to the end of racing.

VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEM:

Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures

- a) It is compulsory for all Competitors to fit a camera to their Kart in a working condition from the start of the first practice session at each Meeting in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 8 i) (iv). Failure to do so during Practice will result in Disqualification of the Competitor from the next practice session. In the event of it being the final practice session of the day the Competitor will start from the rear of the grid in Qualifying.
- b) A separate SD Card must be used for each Class contested at a Meeting.
- c) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of a Round, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.
- d) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until 0700 hours the next day, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.

FURTHER NOTES

Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.

No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.

No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the event.

The Club does have EFTPOS facilities available trackside.

Camping Will be available at the event. Caravans, Campervans, Motorhomes, are to park in the designated parking area in Lease Area B located in between the Ipswich Kart Circuit and Willowbank Raceway. These will not be permitted in the pit area. Lease Area B does not have power supply however additional toilets and showers will be available in this section.
